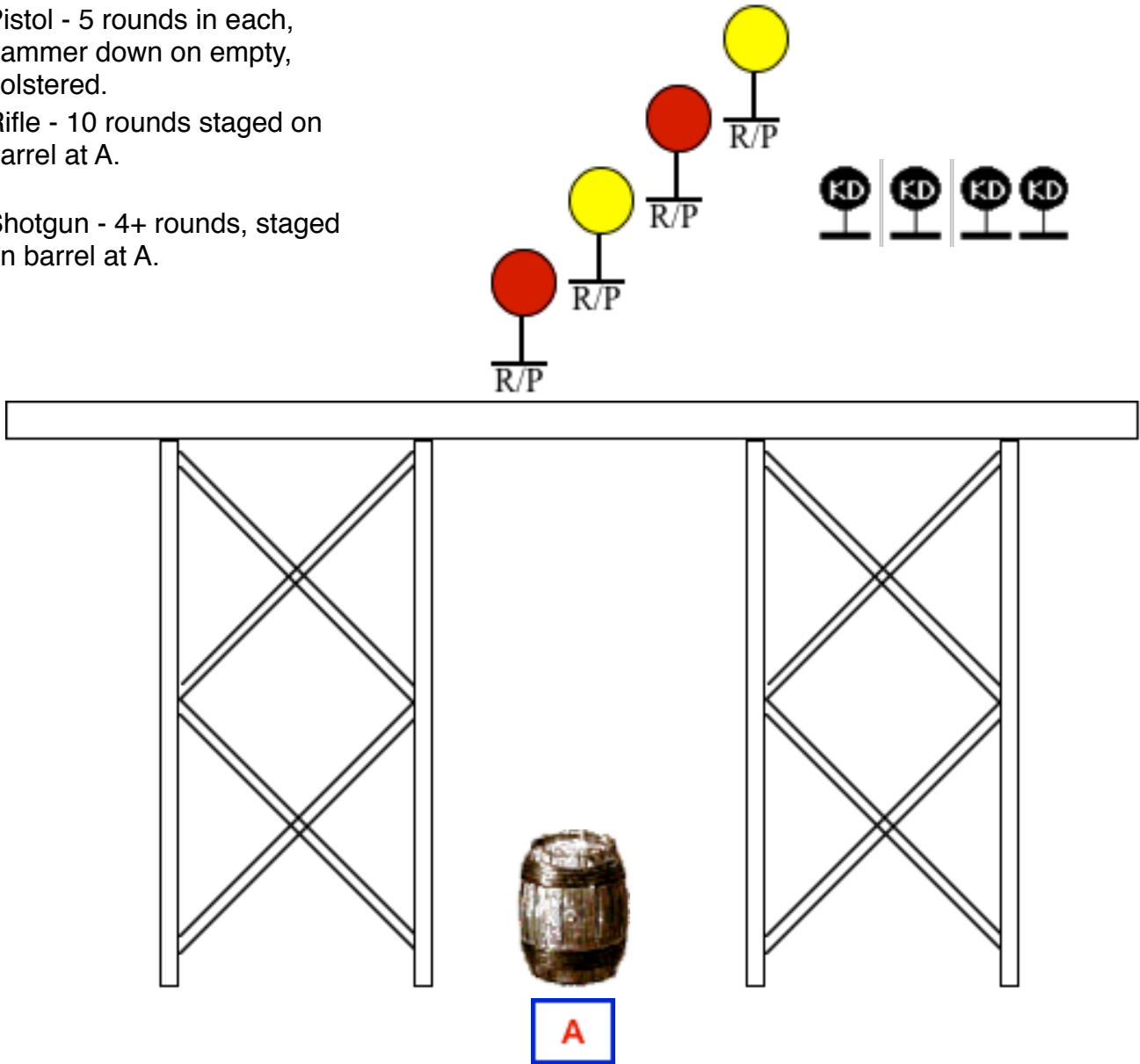


Stage 3: Canadian Pacific

- Pistol - 5 rounds in each, hammer down on empty, holstered.
- Rifle - 10 rounds staged on barrel at A.
- Shotgun - 4+ rounds, staged on barrel at A.



Shooter begins at A, hands touching hat, on head. Shooter's choice as to order of forearm, rifle cannot be last.

Shooter indicates ready by saying, "If you want to know who's boss here, start something."

On Signal: Engage the rifle/pistol targets with 2 shots on a target, 4 shots on a target, 6 shots on a target, and 8 shots on a target. It is up to the shooter to decide which target receives the required number of shot as there no numerical sequence for shots. Engage shotgun knockdowns in any order. Long guns are made safe on barrel at A.
